

Trappist Ales



*Bruin Trappist #8 *Achel* SINT-BENEDICTUSABDIJ de ACHELSE KLUIS: Namont-Achel, Belgium

This is a beer that shows a dark chestnut colour in the glass. A pale creamy froth, not unlike a bubble bath, floats onto the surface of this delicious Trappist beer. The Bruin has some surprisingly fruity aromas, of pear, banana, raisin and plum. Its taste betrays touches of caramel, biscuits, cakes and cookies. The malty palate is freshened up by a beautiful pearlisisation, and it all culminates in a well-rounded bitterness. 8% Alcohol.

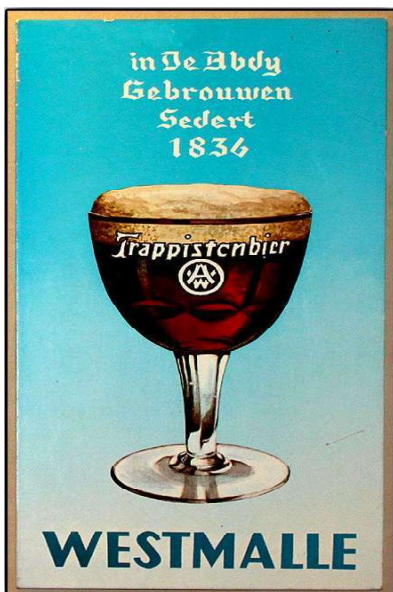

*Dubbel Trappist Ale *Westmalle* ABDIJ TRAPPISTEN WESTMALLE: West Malle, Belgium

Characterised by notes of caramel, malt and fruity esters reminiscent of ripe banana. The first taste of Westmalle Dubbel is a creamy thick head of foam. When finished, the beer leaves lacework traces behind in the glass, but the most memorable part of this balanced Trappist beer with soft mouthfeel is undoubtedly the long, dry finish. 7% Alcohol.

*Chimay Grand Reserve *Trappist Ale* ABBAYE DE SCOURMONT: Chimay, Belgium

The Abbey's version of a Quadrupel, with a creamy head and a fragrance of fresh yeast and roasted malt. Considered to be the "classic" Chimay ale, it exhibits considerable depth with hints of plum, raisin & nutmeg. A remarkable ale. 9% Alcohol.

"Dark brown in the glass with a nice tan head and lots of sediment floaties. Malty, brown bread, fig and earthy on the nose. Deep flavors of brandied dried fruits and clove. Brown bread, prune, and slight anise. Finishes with a hint of Christmas orange pierced with cloves.

*Chimay Premier *Barrel Aged Trappist* ABBAYE DE SCOURMONT: Chimay, Belgium

The first of its kind, Chimay Première Red Barrel Fermented offers a unique experience. A blend of Chimay Premier (Barley & Wheat), triple fermented in both 60% American oak barrels and 40% French oak barrels. This 2023 release offers barrel derived flavors of wood, smoke with perfect balance between oak and Chimay Première. Unfiltered, unpasteurized, this beer has an incomparable rounded, wooden flavor. Contains barley and wheat. 8.5% Alcohol.

*Chimay Premier Ale *Trappist Ale* ABBAYE DE SCOURMONT: Chimay, Belgium

This coppery-brown Trappist Ale has a creamy head and a light, fruity aroma. Flavors of caramel, apricot and roasted spice are tempered by a refreshing, lightly bitter astringency. Top fermented and refermented in the bottle. This was the Abbey's first ale, produced in 1862. 7% Alcohol.

*Quadrupel Trappist Ale *La Trappe* BROUWERIJ DE KONINGSHOEVEN: Koningshoeven, Netherlands

This pioneering Quadrupel has a beautiful deep amber color and a lasting tan head. The aroma is of dark fruits and caramel; the warm taste is full and well-balanced; sweet notes of cherry, raisin, plum and vanilla are complemented by a pleasantly bitter and lasting finish. 10% Alcohol.

"the Quadrupel's warm and intense flavour is rich and finely balanced. Malty sweet, slightly burnt, and pleasantly bitter with a sweet aftertaste. Quadrupel continues to ferment after bottling and offers aromas of banana, almond, vanilla and others. Outstanding. Score 95." THE BEER ADVOCATE

*Trappist Ambree Ale *Monts des Cats* SAINTE-MARIE ABBEY DU MONTS-DES-CATS: Godewaersvelde, France

After almost a century the Trappist Abbey of Mont des Cats in the north of France has resumed its brewing tradition dating back to 1847. Heavy bombardment during the last battle of Ypres in 1918 destroyed the brewery and it was not rebuilt. In the summer of 2011 Monts des Cats became a beer-producing Trappist abbey, the only such abbey in France. 7.6% Alcohol.

"A pleasant caramel malt sweetness introduces the beer, joined by hints of dried fruits, gentle spices and an earthy, herbal hop character. The abbey only makes one beer, with no intention for more. Outstanding." THE BEER ADVOCATE

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*Trappist Ale *Orval*

ABBAYE NOTRE-DAME D'ORVAL: Florenville, Belgium

Brewed unfiltered by Catholic monks at the legendary monastery founded in 1100AD in the pastoral Belgium countryside, 30 miles from the French Border. Three different malts and two types of hops are used, with Brettanomyces yeast that imparts great character and complexity. A true treasure that everyone should enjoy at least once. The Orval's brewery famously produces just one beer. 6.9% Alcohol.

*Trappist Ale #8 *Rochefort*

BRASSERIE DE ROCHEFORT: Rochefort, Belgium

Deep golden-brown with red highlights. The aroma features fresh fruit, spice, leather, figs, and a hint of smokiness. Flavor is complex, with date, caramel, and brown sugar notes accompanied by spicy coriander, nutty yeast, and herbal hoppiness. It ages well and can be cellared for at least five years while maintaining quality. 9.2% Alcohol.

*Trappist Ale *Tynt Meadow*

MOUNT ST. BERNARD ABBEY: Leicestershire, England

One of 10 brewing Trappist monasteries in the world, Tynt Meadow is the only Trappist brewery in England. A strong dark ale, but one with a clearly English character. Tynt Meadow is mahogany-colored, with a subtle, warm red hue, and a lasting beige head. Its aroma carries hints of dark chocolate, licorice, and rich fruit flavors. The beer is full-bodied, gently balancing the taste of dark chocolate, pepper, and fig. It leaves a warm and dry finish on the palate. 7.4% Alcohol.

*Trappist Ale #10 *Rochefort*

BRASSERIE DE ROCHEFORT: Rochefort, Belgium

Dark brown with a bouquet of port wine, leather, apricots, spices and a touch of bittersweet chocolate. Its complex, dark fruit flavors are balanced by a firm malt backbone. One of the world's most intriguing beverages. 11.3% Alcohol.

*Trappist Ale #6 *Rochefort*

BRASSERIE DE ROCHEFORT: Rochefort, Belgium

A Dubbel style beer brewed by Brasserie de Rochefort. Reddish-brown with amber-gold highlights. A refined, soft spiciness in the bouquet finishes with an intense taste of caramel, fruit, and hints of raisins. Bottle-conditioned with live yeasts for soft natural carbonation, it ages well and can be cellared for at least five years while maintaining quality. Gold Medal winner-World Beer Championships. 7.5% Alcohol.

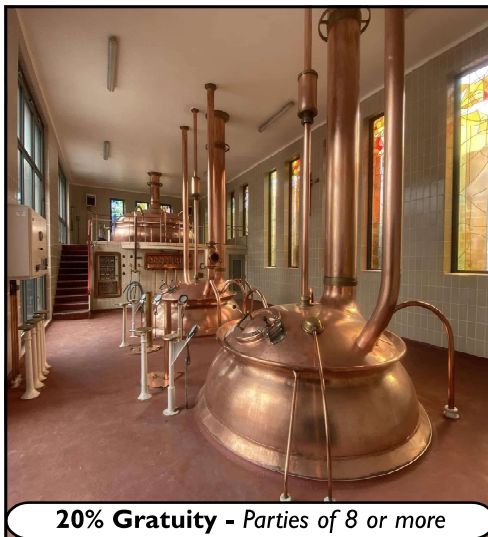


*Trappist Ale #8 *Zundert*

ABDIJ MARIA TOEVLUCHT: Zundert, Netherlands

Brewed by the Trappist monks within the walls of Abbey Maria Toevlucht in the town of Zundert in the Netherlands. Clear chestnut-colored and bottle-conditioned, with an aroma of caramel, herbs and spices, its initial impression is floral and slightly sweet; its character develops from light caramel to a lovely, dry, mellow hoppy bitterness as the flavor opens. Zundert 8 evolves with each taste and defines a new chapter in the book of excellent Trappist ales. 8% Alcohol.
